Dr. Rachel Squier is the only board-certified female prosthodontist in Florida. At UCONN, she also completed her specialty residency and earned her master's degree. Her practice, Treasure Coast Dental, offers such procedures as crowns, bridges, implants, dentures and veneers. "In addition to being a specialist with an ability to treat complex conditions, I do provide general dentistry services," she says. "I like to emphasize my extensive training and expertise, but I want patients to consider seeing us because we are thoughtful and meticulous in our care.
